Clinically Managed Low-Intensity Residential Treatment Services 8D-3 ASAM 3.1

Clinically Managed Low-Intensity Residential Treatment Services is a new Medicaid service being added to the State Plan and assigned a daily per diem reimbursement rate. This policy is being revised to reflect the 2013 American Society of Addiction Services are provided in a 24-hour residential facility with clinical and supportive services. Clinically Managed Low-Intensity Residential Treatment Services is designed for adult beneficiaries who experience functional limitations due to a substance use disorder; have living situations that are incompatible with their recovery goals; and would benefit from a structured, safe, and supportive living environment. Clinical and supportive services include individual, group, and family therapy; referral and coordination for medication management, medication education, mental health evaluation and treatment as medically necessary; referral for laboratory and toxicology services; coordination with primary and preventative healthcare; vocational rehabilitation and job placement; introductory or remedial life skills workshops; and psychoeducation.

This amendment will become effective July 1, 2024.
