



Behavioral Health and Intellectual/Developmental Disability Tailored Plan

Data on Medicaid and NC Health Choice Beneficiary Eligibility for Behavioral Health I/DD Tailored Plans and Tailored Care Management May 24, 2021

I. Overview

In response to stakeholder requests and feedback, the Department of Health and Human Services (the Department) is releasing data on the number of Medicaid and NC Health Choice beneficiaries, as of April 2021, who currently meet the eligibility criteria to enroll in Behavioral Health and Intellectual/Developmental Disability (I/DD) Tailored Plans and receive Tailored Care Management scheduled to launch in July 2022.

The table below (Table 1) shows this information in aggregate and broken down by county and condition. Statewide, approximately 200,000 current Medicaid and NC Health Choice beneficiaries meet one or more criterion for Behavioral Health I/DD Tailored Plan eligibility as defined [here](#). The number of beneficiaries who will enroll in a Behavioral Health I/DD Tailored Plan in 2022 may vary for a variety of reasons, including:

- The total number of Medicaid and NC Health Choice beneficiaries is expected to decrease following the end of the federal COVID-19 public health emergency.
- The Department may make updates to the Behavioral Health I/DD Tailored Plan eligibility criteria, including a more recent lookback period for qualifying behavioral health claims.

Note: these data include approximately 46,000 individuals dually eligible for Medicare and Medicaid; however, the Department has not yet obtained legislative authorization to enroll this group in Behavioral Health I/DD Tailored Plans for behavioral health and I/DD services.

Key characteristics of the expected Behavioral Health I/DD Tailored Plan population across the State include:

- 58% have a behavioral health condition, 20% have an I/DD or traumatic brain injury (TBI), and 15% have a co-occurring behavioral health condition and I/DD. Condition-specific data are unavailable for the remaining 7%.
- 62% are adults and 38% are children.

As shown below, these distributions vary by county.

The Department anticipates that providers applying for certification as an Advanced Medical Home Plus (AMH+) or Care Management Agency (CMA) may find these data useful in understanding the future Behavioral Health I/DD Tailored Plan population.
