BRYAN FLYNN will have a new health plan

Starting December 1, 2025, NC Medicaid will have a new type of health plan for children, youth and young adults currently and formerly served by Child Welfare Services. It is called the Children and Families Specialty Plan.

Health plan services start December 1, 2025

BRYAN FLYNN will start getting health care from the Children and Families Specialty Plan on the start date above. Until then, BRYAN FLYNN will get health care the way they do now. BRYAN FLYNN's Medicaid ID Number is 472332249O and their health plan is Vaya Health.

1. What to know about the Children and Families Specialties Plan

- Get physical health care, like regular check-ups and preventive care.
- Get pharmacy, behavioral health services and more.
- Get Care Management in all 100 counties to help support needs and reach health goals.
- Get statewide coordination with local Department of Social Services (DSS) and Child Welfare team.
- Choose doctors in the health plan's provider network (group).

The health plan has added services for members who qualify. Look at the **Health Care Option** Guide in this packet.

2. Choose or change BRYAN FLYNN's primary care provider (PCP) by calling 1-833-777-3611

A PCP is a doctor, nurse practitioner, physician assistant or other provider. They care for your health, coordinate your needs and refer you to specialists when you need them. Your health plan can tell you which PCPs are in their provider group.

The health plan will choose a PCP for BRYAN FLYNN. If you want to change BRYAN FLYNN's PCP, call **1-833-777-3611**. BRYAN FLYNN can still see any NC Medicaid enrolled provider.

For a full list of providers, including PCPs in the health plan's group, go to <u>ncmedicaidplans.gov</u>. Or you can call the health plan, and they will give you a list of providers to choose from.

The health plan's provider group includes behavioral health providers (such as a psychiatrist or therapist), hospitals and other care facilities. The Children and Families Specialty Plan must have enough hospitals and providers for BRYAN FLYNN to get covered services near them and in a timely way.

3. What happens next?

The new health plan will send details and a new ID card in the mail. BRYAN FLYNN will use the ID card to get health care services. If you have questions, call the health plan at the number listed on BRYAN FLYNN's ID card.

Know BRYAN FLYNN's Health Care Options

BRYAN FLYNN is not required to stay enrolled with the Children and Families Specialty Plan. There are other choices.

BRYAN FLYNN can choose a **Standard Plan** or a **Behavioral Health and Intellectual/Developmental Disabilities Tailored Plan**.

Standard Plans and Tailored Plans are NC Medicaid Managed Care health plans. Both offer physical health, pharmacy, care coordination and basic behavioral health services for members. The Children and Families Specialty Plan offers personalized services and supports for your unique needs.

The **Know Your Health Care Options** included in this letter will tell you the steps to choose a **Standard Plan** or **Tailored Plan**. You must call us before BRYAN FLYNN can move to a Standard Plan or Tailored Plan. We will explain BRYAN FLYNN's health care options. This is to help you make the best choice for BRYAN FLYNN's individual needs. If you have an Authorized Representative, they can call for BRYAN FLYNN.

The Health Care Option Guide included with this letter lists the Standard Plans and Tailored Plan BRYAN FLYNN can choose from. There is only one Tailored Plan for each county.

After December 1, 2025, BRYAN FLYNN will get health care through the Children and Families Specialty Plan listed above unless:

- They chose to enroll in a Standard Plan or Tailored Plan
- They are notified they can choose a different health plan
- They no longer qualify for the Children and Families Specialty Plan
