Re: Additional Allocation of CAP-MR/DD Waiver Slots

Dear County Director of Social Services:

The Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Services will add an additional 350 individuals to the CAP-MR/DD waiver. The slots will be divided among the LME's on a per capita basis. LME's will be responsible for prioritizing individuals for participation in the waiver. A number of the slots have been reserved for individuals who will be transitioned from the Developmental Centers to a residential setting in the community. A chart listing the number of slots allocated to each LME is attached for your convenience.

A timeframe for moving individuals into the waiver has not been established by DMH/DD/SAS; however, you may see an increase in Medicaid applications over the next few months for new waiver recipients.
