## Re: Application Time Standards Chart For 2006

Dear Medicaid Supervisor:

Attached is a copy of the <u>Application Time Standards Chart for 2006</u>. The chart includes the calculated 13<sup>th</sup>, 45<sup>th</sup>, 60<sup>th</sup>, and 90<sup>th</sup> calendar day for each day of the year in 2006. It also includes the 6<sup>th</sup> month date for each day. Caseworkers who work with Medicaid, including Work First, applications may utilize this chart to determine the necessary application time standards rather than calculating each date manually.

This chart does not consider weekends and holidays in the 45<sup>th</sup>, 60<sup>th</sup>, and 90<sup>th</sup> day calculations. To determine the adjusted due date of an application, compare the due date listed on the chart to the calendar and your county holiday schedule. If the chart calculated due date falls on a weekend or county holiday, the adjusted due date is the next workday. The Adjusted Application Management Report, in XPTR, calculates and displays the adjusted due date.
