Each county is being asked to help find phone numbers for recipients residing in the county who have been chosen by random sample to participate in a patient satisfaction survey. The purpose of the survey is to gather information about how well they perceive their health care as a member of Carolina ACCESS. The survey is being conducted by the University of North Carolina at Charlotte and surveys will be done through telephone interviews using a national standardized survey tool called CAHPS. The names on these spreadsheets are recipients for whom we were not able to get phone numbers from EIS. The spreadsheets were sent to all counties on June 12, 2006. If you did not receive them, please call the managed care section of the Division of Medical Assistance at 919-647-8170.

- 1. Each county received two (2) excel spreadsheets. One spreadsheet lists recipients under age 21. The second spreadsheet lists recipients 21 years of age and over.
- 2. The spreadsheet contains information that should help identify the recipient: name, MID, address, case head etc. This information comes from data found in EIS.
- 3. For each number found, please write it in the end column which is labeled phone number.
- 4. Return the spreadsheets to the address below by July 3, 2006:
