The purpose of this letter is to inform you about a change within the Managed Care Organization (MCO). Western Highland Network will merge with Smokey Mountain Center effective October 1, 2013. Smokey Mountain Center will now serve Alexander, Alleghany, Ashe, Avery, Buncombe, Caldwell, Cherokee, Clay, Graham, Haywood, Henderson, Jackson, Macon, Madison, McDowell, Mitchell, Polk, Rutherford, Swain, Transylvania, Watauga, Wilkes, and Yancey counties.

Former Western Highlands Network beneficiaries will be mailed new Medicaid cards with updated MCO information and welcome letters. The welcome letters inform beneficiaries residing in the affected counties of the change and effective date.
