

PUBLIC NOTICE
(SPA 17-001)
Graduate Medical Education Elimination

The Department of Health and Human Resources, Division of Medical Assistance hereby provides notice of its intent to amend the Medicaid State Plan page 4.19-A, Page 5 and Supplement 1, Page 3 for the purpose of removing Graduate Medical Education reimbursement. Senate Bill 119, Section 12H.23.(a) states no Medicaid provider may receive reimbursement for Graduate Medical Education (GME) as an add-on to their DRG Unit Value (Base) rate under the Base rate methodology as defined in the current Medicaid State Plan. There will be no further adjustments this state fiscal year.

This amendment will become effective January 1, 2017.

The annual estimated state fiscal impact of this change is:

- a. SFY 2017 (\$14,240,816)
- b. SFY 2018 (\$29,255,166)
