(CAP/C) Stakeholders

The N.C. Division of Medical Assistance (DMA) submitted the Community Alternatives Program for Children (CAP/C) Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) waiver amendment to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) on Dec. 2, 2016. The amendment will accomplish:

- 1. Continuation of waiver services for children who are determined to be medically-complex, and,
- 2. Compliance with the requirements for the HCBS Final Rule established by CMS
