This Agreement amends the contract bearing the effective date of July 1, 2017 ("Contract"), between the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (the "Department"), Division of Medical Assistance ("Division" or "DMA") and Alliance Behavioral Healthcare ("Contractor" or "PIHP"). This Amendment is hereby effective upon execution on behalf of both parties.

As provided for under the terms of the Contract, DMA and PIHP agree to amend the following Contract provisions:

1. Reference Attachment BB - In Lieu of Services: Add the following summary of the full In Lieu of Service definition for the High Fidelity Wraparound Team:

Service Name: High Fidelity Wraparound Team (HFWT)

Procedure Codes: H0032-U3 and H0032-U3-22

Approved: 06/29/18

In lieu of: PRTFs, Residential Level III

Description: High Fidelity Wraparound is an intensive, team-based, person-centered service that provides coordinated, holistic, family-driven care to meet the complex needs of youth/young adults who are involved with multiple systems (e.g. mental health, child welfare, juvenile/criminal justice, special education), experience serious emotional or behavioral difficulties, are at risk of placement in Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facilities (PRTFs) or other institutional settings, or are aging out of Department of Social Services (DSS) care.

Other Requirements:

All other terms and conditions as set forth in the original contract document shall remain in effect for the duration of this Agreement.


