Congratulations on enrolling in NC Medicaid! Unfortunately, your current drug prescription was written by a doctor and/or provider who is not enrolled in NC Medicaid.

Here are some next steps you can take to receive your medication:

- Reach out to your current doctor/provider to see if there is another NC Medicaid doctor/provider in that practice who can write you a new prescription.
 - a. If your current provider is a free clinic which can provide your medications, reach out to them to see if they can fill your prescription at the clinic.
- 2. Reach out to your Health Plan Member Line or the Medicaid Contact Center (the phone number is listed on the back of your Medicaid ID card) to find a doctor/provider that you can see to write you a new prescription.
- 3. If you have an immediate need for this medication or are experiencing a medical emergency, please visit the nearest urgent care facility or emergency department.
