Current Year NC Medicaid Budget (SFY 2023)

Key Factors:

- Continuation of the public health emergency (PHE)
 - Currently expires January 11, 2023
 - Causes increased enrollment, but provides enhanced FMAP (6.2 percentage points)
- Extending COVID rate increases for SNF, PCS
- Launching Tailored Care Management (12/1) and Tailored Plans (4/1)

Looking Ahead to next Biennium (SFY 2024)

Key Factors:

- Decreases in FMAP percentage
- PHE unwinding
- First full year of TP implementation
- New High-cost Pharmaceuticals
- Addressing direct care workforce
- Medicaid Expansion
