NC Medicaid is reimbursing COVID-19 testing costs for individuals without insurance who enroll in the NC Medicaid Optional COVID-19 Testing (MCV) program. Individuals must also be a resident of North Carolina and meet the citizenship and legal immigration status requirements of the Medicaid program.
