If you have NC Medicaid, you may be eligible to get similar services while you are on the NC Innovations waiver waitlist.

These services are called "1915(i) services," and they offer help with daily activities, job coaching and more.
There is no waitlist for enrollment.

The NC Innovations waiver covers a full range of services for people with intellectual or developmental disabilities.

## The NC Innovations waiver offers:



Help with daily activities



Car and home modifications

Day programs



Group homes

**Plus:** With NC Medicaid, you can also get health and dental coverage and rides to appointments.

Anyone can apply regardless of age, insurance or income.

# The NC Innovations waiver is for people who:



This may include autism, cerebral palsy, Down syndrome, traumatic brain injury (if the injury happened before age 22) and more.

And need a lot of support, now and in the future.

For instance, your loved one may need help to take care of themselves, like bathing or dressing. Or they may need help to live on their own, like cooking or working. (In technical terms, this is called meeting ICF-IID level of care, which means they have needs similar to people placed in an intermediate care facility. You do not need to know this to apply.)

### Not sure if your loved one is eligible?

We encourage you to apply anyway. Secure your spot on the waitlist.





## Apply as soon as you have a diagnosis.

Even though there is a waitlist, we encourage you to apply, especially if services may be needed in the future.

People who have extraordinary circumstances or emergencies may be eligible to skip the waitlist.
