## What is North Carolina Money Follows the Person (NC MFP)?

The MFP program:

- Help people who live in places like hospitals, nursing homes, or a care center for people with disabilities move into homes in their own communities.
- Gives more choice for where people want to live and get help.
- Looks for ways to fix problems that make it hard for people to get care at home.

# Are You Eligible? To move with MFP, a person must:

- Live in a hospital, nursing home, or a care center for people with disabilities for at least 60 days
- Be eligible for community-based Medicaid
- Approved for home and community services
- Choose to move into a "qualified home," like:
  - A family member's home
  - A group home with 4 or fewer people (only allowed in some cases in NC)

#### What Help Can You Get?

- 1. Accessing NC Medicaid Support
  People in the MFP program can get
  community services faster. This includes
  special Medicaid programs.
- 2. Planning Your Move Home: The program offers help with moving.

Help includes paying for:

- Staff training
- Rent deposits
- Starting utilities like electricity
- Furniture
- Home changes like ramps
- Other one-time things, like food
