What is North Carolina Money Follows the Person (NC MFP)?

The MFP program:

- Help people who live in places like hospitals, nursing homes, or a care center for people with disabilities move into homes in their own communities.
- Gives more choice for where people want to live and get help.
- Looks for ways to fix problems that make it hard for people to get care at home.

Are You Eligible?

To move with MFP, a person must:

- Live in a hospital, nursing home, or a care center for people with disabilities for at least 60 days
- Be eligible for community-based Medicaid
- Approved for home and community services
- Choose to move into a "qualified home," like:
 - A family member's home
 - A group home with 4 or fewer people (only allowed in some cases in NC)

What Help Can You Get?

1. Accessing NC Medicaid Support
People in the MFP program can get community services faster. This includes special Medicaid programs.

2. Planning Your Move Home:
The program offers help with moving.

Help includes paying for:

- Staff training
- Rent deposits
- Starting utilities like electricity
- Furniture
- Home changes like ramps
- Other one-time things, like food
