
# **Enrollment & Expenditures: Adding Expansion**

- There is <u>no Expansion enrollment</u> until December 1, 2023.
- Expansion enrollment will be <u>tracked separately</u>
- Expansion expenditures will be <u>tracked</u> <u>separately</u> and will not affect State General Fund expenditures/rebase funds
- For clarity, we will refer to "Non-Expansion (Non-Exp)" and "Expansion (Exp)" Enrollment & Expenditures

# **NC Medicaid point-in-time Non-Expansion Enrollment**




### **Projected v Actual Non-Expansion Medicaid Enrollment**

From July-September 2023, NC Medicaid spent approximately \$5.48 billion.



## **Pressure on Current Year Medicaid Budget**

- Medicaid Rebase funding lower than requested amt
- Medicaid Transformation funding lower than requested amt
- Continuous Coverage Unwinding (CCU) enrollment declines progressing at slower rate than projected
- Recurring contractual shortfalls for technology infrastructure (NC Tracks, NC Analytics) growing annually
