# Fact Sheet NC Medicaid Expansion

### Medicaid Expansion Launched Dec. 1, 2023

Medicaid expansion allows more people to get health care coverage. The eligible population will increase for adults ages 19 through 64 earning up to 138% of the Federal Poverty Level.

Single adults earning about \$20,000 per year or families of three with an annual income of about \$34,000 may be eligible.

#### MEDICAID EXPANSION ENROLLMENT CRITERIA

Most people will be able to get health care coverage through Medicaid if they meet the guidelines. Some of these include:

- Live in North Carolina
- Are Ages 19-64
- Are an US citizen. Non-US citizens with a valid immigration status may be eligible.
- If your household income fits within the list below

HOUSEHOLD SIZE	TOTAL INCOME, BEFORE TAXES
Single Adults	\$1,732/month
Family of 2	\$2,392/month
Family of 3	\$2,969/month
Family of 4	\$3,588/month

\*Income limits are updated April 1 each year.
