Children & Families Specialty Plan Goes Live – December 1, 2025



- New Statewide Initiative: Administered by Blue Cross Healthy Blue Together
- Designed for children, youth, and families
- Replaces traditional Foster Care program
 - > Expands services beyond foster children
 - ➤ Includes at-risk children, former foster youth, and families working toward reunification
- Integrated & coordinated Care
 - > Combines physical and behavioral health services
 - > Broad access to physical, behavioral, and long-term services
- Prevention-Focused
 - > Family-centered care to reduce foster care entry/re-entry



Updated Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) Requirements for All NCTracks Users

NCTracks is changing the User Login process, implementing MFA updates for all users in 2025.

This transition will occur in phases – **users will be contacted via email** when their account is scheduled to change to MFA.

The notification you receive will outline the steps to be taken in order to update your profile.

Federal Fee Increase for Medicaid Enrollment

- Effective: January 1, 2025
- Increase from \$709 to \$730 for the 2025 calendar year
- Applies to:
 - Re-enrollment
 - Adding a new owner/site location
 - Re-verification


Notification Required for Change in Ownership (CHOW)

- Provider to notify Department at least 30 days prior to CHOW
- Provider Change of Ownership Disclosure Form
- Former and new owners must make changes to NC Tracks enrollment record

Keeping NCTracks Provider Record Updated – Why it Matters



NCTracks is official Source of Truth for Medicaid

- > Provider's responsibility to keep records accurate and updated
- > Ensures contractual compliance and efficient operations

Downstream Effects of Outdated Data

- > Claims denials and payment delays
- > Incorrect provider directories
- Disrupted patient access to care
- Inaccurate reporting from NCTracks


Patient Impact

- Difficulty in locating in-network providers
- > Patients may contact outdated or unavailable providers
- Access to oral interpretation services

Education Transcripts No Longer Required for North Carolina Medical Board Licensed Providers

- Effective Jan. 8, 2025
- School transcripts no longer required for NCMB-licensed providers
- Reduces administrative burden and simplifies enrollment
- Aligns with NCQA compliance standards
- NCMB's Primary Source Verification (PSV) confirms education and training
- NCTracks will use state license agencies for verification when applicable

Telehealth Services

- New Federal Law & Compliance
 - > Providers must now report:
 - Telehealth services offered
 - Office website availability
 - American Sign Language (ASL) support
- . Changes to NCTracks
 - > NCTracks currently doesn't collect this information during enrollment
 - > The NC Division of Health Benefits (DHB) is working with GDIT to update the system
 - > Not all covered services are available, e.g. eye and dental exams
- . Timeline
 - Updates go live in NCTracks by July 1, 2025



NC Medicaid Provider Ombudsman

- Initially created to support providers transitioning to Managed Care
 - Consists of Provider Operations and DHB Call Center teams
 - Inquiry responses are delivered via Service Now email
- Most important resource for providers looking to resolve issues with PHPs, NCTracks, and/or provider enrollment
- Should only be used as an escalation measure AFTER contacting Health Plans and utilizing online Help Center for assistance
