PUBLIC NOTICE (SPA #22-0022) (Revised) Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC)

The Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Health Benefits hereby provides notice of its intent to revise the FQHC reimbursement section Attachment 4.19B of the Medicaid State Plan. This amendment will revise the FQHC Cost Based Alternate Payment Methodology (APM) for State Fiscal Year 2022-2023 dates of service. The current Cost Based APM reconciles interim payments received to the greater of the provider specific Prospective Payment System APM rate or 100% of the provider's Medicaid allowable cost. This amendment will allow reconciliation of interim payments received to the greater of the provider specific Prospective Payment System APM rate or <u>113%</u> of the provider's Medicaid allowable cost. This temporary reimbursement revision is intended to support FQHC's financial viability in the face of increased costs not captured in standard costs reports and to strengthen North Carolina's array of safety net medical care providers.

This amendment will become effective July 1, 2022.
